Besides the oral presentation you need to bring a digital poster to present at the SAGIM meeting.

During the PhD day we will select the 5 best presentations and they will be asked to present orally at the SAGIM meeting the next day. The oral presentation at the meeting will be awarded with a travel grant of 500 DKK.
